This year we are retaining young sire W252. This 120kg sire is a son of Moorundie K200 who was sired by PB202. He has outstanding wool suited to high rainfall and agricultural areas. He tests as a pure poll.

After topping the Hamilton Ram Sale in 2016, NE073 was entered in sire evaluation trials in three states. He has performed well in both high rainfall and agricultural environments.

Early results show that he is a trait leader for weaning and post weaning weights, is a leader for high fleece weight and has below average micron.

In one trial he produced no culls and had a low number of culls in others. This is not only due to his production of wool and meat, but his great structure leads to few conformation faults. Tested as pure poll. Of the ten rams sold in Hamilton for more then \$10,000, five were by NE073. Five studs at Bendigo Sheep Sale displayed his progeny.
