2022 has certainly shown the resilience of the Merino industry and that strong fundamentals are underpinning our prices. This year, we are continuing to offer rams only at the Moorundie on property sale and privately by appointment. We are continuing to take our flock on the path of higher muscle, fat, early growth and fertility. Our 19 micron wool has been a terrific advantage this year, with our 17 micron weaners wool attracting large premiums. The first FM flock progeny will be available for purchase this year. Both our flocks will strive to improve the profit drivers of meat, wool and fertility, however we are targeting a lower adult weight for the FM flock. The trial with the measured performance flock showed that the Moorundie sheep performed well, achieving higher fertility, muscle and fat.

First to achieve a new record were the Tiller and Thompson 1.5 year old ewes selling for \$404 at Marrabel, to top off a great year their woolclip was recognised as the Elders clip of the year for 2021.

This price was eclipsed by the Allen families Warrawee Park/Moorundie blood ewes attaining \$408 for their 1.5 year old ewes at the Keith off shears ewe sale in October.

This years team is our first major influence from NE73 008 "Lightning". He has bred well in all studs where he has been used and his progeny, measure high for fat and eye muscle. Our other new family S 200, is breeding productive rams and we have several new NE 73 families performing well as they always do.





The FM family has the same breeding objectives as the Moorundie flock, high fertility, fat and muscle, with 19 micron wool. We are listening to parts of the industry who are having trouble with big sheep and will limit the adult body weight in the FM flock. All of the Moorundie flock is striving for high fleece weight on plain bodies. We believe that the plainer-bodied sheep are faster growing, more fertile and will be more appropriate in an industry with increasing animal welfare concerns.
